Ascension Academy Tuition and Fees August 1, 2001

The policy is that each student enrolled in Ascension Academy must pay a one time application fee, a yearly registration fee, and full yearly tuition. Each year the tuition rates at Ascension are proposed by the Executive Committee to the Board of Directors for approval. Failure to pay tuition in a timely manner may lead to dismissal of the student.

The fees for School Year 2001-2002 are as follows:

Application Fee:

\$75.00 paid the first time a student enrolls

Registration Fee:

Paid in full on registration (no discount for late registration)

Middle School \$ 200 High School \$ 300

Middle School Tuition:

\$ 4,900 paid in ten (or twelve) monthly payments by credit card (begins in July)

\$ 4,760 paid in ten (or twelve) monthly payments by check or cash (begins in July)

\$ 4,550 paid in two semester payments (July & December)

\$ 4,330 paid in full in July

High School Tuition:

\$ 5,590 paid in ten (or twelve) monthly payments by credit card (begins in July)

\$ 5,430 paid in ten (or twelve) monthly payments by check or cash (begins in July)

\$ 5,190 paid in two semester payments (July & December)

\$ 4,940 paid in full in July

Family Discount:

If a family has more than one student at Ascension, full tuition is paid by the oldest student and a 10% discount per student is applied to the tuition for the siblings.

Tuition Contracts

During School Year 2001-02, all tuition contracts between parents and Ascension will be made with the Business Manager, with approval of Executive Committee on deviation from full tuition.

Tuition Assistance Policy for Subsequent Years

The applicant who requests a deviation from the policy must follow the procedure outlined below on an annual basis:

- 1. After acceptance of the student into Ascension, the family completes an application for financial aid, returning it with the appropriate documentation and fee to School and Student Services for Financial Aid (SSSFA).
- 2. SSSFA forwards a recommendation of appropriate tuition for the family to the Admissions Committee. The Admissions Committee will review the recommendation of SSSFA. Based upon the funds available for tuition assistance and the requests for financial aid, the committee will determine the amount of tuition.
- 3. Every student must pay the application fee, registration fee, and a certain amount of tuition.
- 4. If a family has a dispute about the tuition as determined by the Admissions Committee, the concern may be made in writing to the President of Ascension, who, after reviewing the concern, and if warranted, will establish an independent review team to assess the concern. After consultation with the review team, the President will make a final decision on the tuition to be paid.
