Uniform Code

The Academy's dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, instill discipline, prevent disruption, avoid safety hazards, and teach respect for authority. The guidelines for the attire of the student body are intended to assure that all students are dressed comfortably, affordably, and according to sociably acceptable norms.

- Socks and or hose are to be worn
- A belt is to be worn with all pants or shorts with belt loops
- All shoes are to be clean and appropriate for school
- Dress uniforms are required on Friday's, for all off campus Academy events, all chapel days, and for special services defined by the administration
- Students have the option to wear shorts on standard uniform days
- Shirts are not to be bloused out more than the bottom of the belt
- No frayed pants
- Skirts are to be at least finger tip length
- Tee-shirts worn under uniform shirts should be mostly plain and not distracting
- No personal coats are to be worn in the classrooms or the halls after school starts
